




Core Facility Genomics





CFG in RDC

- Pre and Post PCR facility labs, support and bioinformatics
- Small fleet of machines available as of December
- Move of all large machines to RDC building in April 2025







Service lab RDC

- Hand in location all CFG services
- pick up point for chemicals etc.
- Machines for general use:
 - Nanodrop and Qubit
 - Uvitec for fluorescence (NIR/IR) and chemiluminescence (ECL ed.) western blots
 - ddPCR
 - 10x Single Cell
 - Blue Pippin / QiaExcel
 - Thermocylers 96 en 384 well
 - Qiacube
 - o LC480
 - Covaris

After relocation in april 2025:

- Speedvac
- Tapestation
- Nanopore sequencing

- Request a VUMC badge from HR if you do not have one
- Create a CFG LIMS account: cfglims.amsterdamumc.nl

 - Send an email to cfg@amsterdamumc.nl to make an appointment.






How to use CFG in the RDC

- Register badge number(s) in CFG LIMS
 - upon creating account
 - Or send email to cfg@amsterdamumc.nl subject: add badge numbers
 - Old green Vumc badge code on right front of badge
 - Old yellow AMC badge code on right back of badge
 - New AmsterdamUMC badge (badge is location specific) on top left corner










How to use CFG in the RDC

- Reserve machines through CFG LIMS
 - (available as of februari 1st)
- Many machines free of charge
 - (for example nanodrop, imagers)
- Some have costs for chemistry / consumables usage
 - (for example ddPCR, Qubit)
- Some machines have a fixed price per usage
 - (for example LC480)

What about the AMC location?

- For now location G2-105.3 remains
- Will move to new location within AMC building in future
- Most currently used machines by customers remain available at AMC
- Isolators, Robots and sequencers (except Ion Torrent) move to RDC location in April 2025.
- Room to facilitate more machines if departments have machines they would like to place in the facility from April onwards.

- WES (automatic western blotting system)
- Plate readers
- o MilliQ
- (for now, 2 robots will stay in the AMC for specific purposes)



Sample flows

- All samples can be submitted at AMC or RDC location
- Samples are transported by CFG between AMC and RDC
- Delivery times as of April still under discussion.

Example:

Sanger sequencing samples

- Currently for diagnostic priority samples:
 - If submitted to CFG AMC before 16.00 hrs samples are processed O.N.
 - Results in CFG Lims before 10.00 hrs next working day.
 - If submitted to CFG RDC before 16.00 hrs samples are transported and processed next working day.
 - Results in CFG Lims before 10.00 hrs after 2 working days
- As of April 2025:
 - If submitted to CFG AMC before 13.30 hrs samples are transported and processed O.N.
 - If submitted to CFG RDC before 16.00 hrs samples are processed O.N.
 - Results in CFG Lims before 10.00 hrs next working day.

Questions



1. How do we get access to the RDC building?

For the CFG it is not yet possible to activate badge access for CFG users to the RDC building. Also, it is not yet possible to add badge numbers in CFG LIMS.

You need to email your badge number of your badge for location VUmc to CFG@amsterdamuc.nl. Then we plan a tour over the lab. With your emailed badge number, we can activate badge access once it is available to us. Untill that time you can call 06 46126777, so we can let you in.

- 2. <u>Does somebody who is already working in the RDC also needs a tour?</u> Yes, anyone who uses the facility requires a tour. The tour will inform you about the houserules and learn were everything is on the labs.
- 3. What is meant by 'we are remaining to keep the same service, but the flow is less then we used to have'? There is no foreseen shutdown of services. Most systems we have in 2 settings of 2 machines. But the capacity will go down to 50%. We will prioritize the diagnostic flows over the research flows. Which period will this be? For the full month of April. Therefor we included the now known transportation times, please consider these. Will it be the same transportation as microbiology flow? Yes, as know now, we are going to be looped in the transport as for the diagnostics labs. Please let us know when problems arise because of the transportation times.
