

## Criteria Amsterdam Movement Sciences Outstanding Paper Award 2022

The Annual AMS Outstanding Paper Award will be presented to a RMA student *or* AMS member PhD candidate at the 5<sup>th</sup> Annual AMS Research Meeting to be held on March 10, 2022, for the most outstanding paper published in the past year. The award consists of a certificate and €1.000 to cover travel costs or attendance to an international scientific meeting of choice, or to cover other research related costs. The applicant must submit a PDF of the article in question.

## Criteria:

- Outstanding paper in its field;
- First authorship (by applicant MA student *or* AMS member PhD candidate) of peer-reviewed article published (online journal, on paper, or alt. e-pub ahead of print) during the period January 1, 2021 December 31, 2021<sup>1</sup>;
- The candidate should be present at the meeting, either in person or online;
- The applicant must have used the correct AMS affiliation on the academic output as part of their own affiliation (i.e.: AMS must be linked to the applicant's name, not just to one of the coauthors);
- All authors must agree with the submission.

## Review:

The papers will be judged by a selection of independent AMS members. The jury's decision is final.

*Note:* the jury will make their judgment based on the following principles:

- Scientific quality;
- The article's innovative and relevant contribution to Amsterdam Movement Sciences;
- Scientific and/or societal relevance.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> The candidate must provide the article's exact volume, issue and page numbers OR in case of a publication in an online journal: the volume and issue number and article number. The paper can only be submitted once (print or online version).
