Criteria Amsterdam Movement Sciences Outstanding Paper Award 2023

The Annual AMS Outstanding Paper Awards will be presented to a MA student, AMS registered PhD candidate or ECR at the 6th AMS Annual Research Meeting to be held on March 23, 2023 for the most outstanding AMS paper published in its category. There is one award in each of the categories 'Basic Science', 'Clinical Science' and 'Sports & Health Science'.

Each award consists of a certificate and €1.000 to cover travel costs, or attendance to an international scientific meeting of choice, or to cover other research related costs. The applicant must submit a PDF of the paper in question.

Criteria:

- Outstanding paper in its field;
- Authorship (by applicant) of peer-reviewed paper published (online journal, on paper, or alt. epub ahead of print) during the period January 1, 2022 – December 31, 2022¹;
- The applicant should present² their work at the Annual AMS Research Meeting;
- The applicant must be a registered AMS member and must have used the correct AMS affiliation;
- The applicant may submit one paper for consideration per year;
- All authors must agree with the submission;
- The submission must include a cover letter (max 1 pp) detailing the applicant's motivation, why they apply to the particular science domain (see above) and why they should win the award.

Review:

The application (cover letter and the paper) will be judged by a selection of independent AMS members. The jury's decision is final.

Note: the jury will make their judgment based on the following principles:

- Scientific quality;
- The paper's innovative and relevant contribution to Amsterdam Movement Sciences;
- Scientific and/or societal relevance;
- The candidate's motivation.

¹ The candidate must provide the paper's exact volume, issue and page numbers OR in case of a publication in an online journal: the volume and issue number and paper number. The paper can only be submitted once (print or online version).

² The winning candidates will be asked to each give a 15-minute presentation of the paper at the AMS Annual Research Meeting.
