

## Amsterdam UMC Fellowship

### **Frequently asked questions:**

*How many applicants are there each round?*

Each year there are about 15-20 eligible candidates, of whom 7-8 are selected for the review rounds and after rebuttal three candidates are invited for an interview.

*How many Fellowships are awarded?*

Each year one Amsterdam UMC Fellowship is granted.

*Is there a maximum amount of times one can apply for the Amsterdam UMC Fellowship?*

No, this is not limited.

*Who are in the Amsterdam UMC Fellowship committee?*

Each research institution is represented in the Amsterdam UMC Fellowship committee by members of the ARB.

*Why can't colleagues with a permanent position apply for the Amsterdam UMC Fellowship?*

The Amsterdam UMC Fellowship is a Tenure Track, offering a talented researcher the opportunity for a permanent position at Amsterdam UMC.

Therefore colleagues who already have a permanent position (without an end date) in our organization cannot apply for the Amsterdam UMC Fellowship.

*When should the candidate who is awarded the Amsterdam UMC Fellowship start the position?*

The candidate should start preferably in the same year as the Amsterdam UMC Fellowship was awarded.
