

Horizon Europe 2021-2027

- Successor of the Horizon 2020 programme
- The EC proposal for Horizon Europe is a €95 billion R&I programme
- Goal: strengthen the EU's scientific and technological bases, boost its innovation capacity and deliver on Europeans' priorities.
- New: Missions
 - Missions address important societal challenges
 - The current five missions are:
 - 1. Adaptation to Climate Change including Societal Transformation
 - 2. Cancer
 - 3. Healthy Oceans, Seas, Coastal and Inland Waters
 - 4. Climate-Neutral and Smart Cities
 - 5. Soil Health and Food

Why applying to Horizon Europe?


- Participation in Horizon Europe provides access to outstanding research networks, infrastructure and new markets;
- Facilitates collaboration among an international consortium incl. non-academic parties;
- International **exposure** of your research;
- Broad application of your results/products/services/policy (not limited to NL);
- Funding rate of 100% (Research and Innovation Actions);
- Provides funding for different stages of development, from fundamental to early stages of clinical research.

Writing a Horizon Europe application might be challenging at first, but can definitely contribute to long-term collaboration, networks and provide a basis to future projects!



Dutch research performs at top level worldwide


- European funding makes up an increasing part of the total public R&D.
- In H2020, The Netherlands received a share
 1.5x bigger as the Dutch investment.
- Dutch researchers are very successful in H2020: only 5 countries receive more funding.

Financiering toegekend aan Nederlandse organisaties


