## Mental health early career researchers

Issues including job insecurity, high work pressure and extensive workload in combination with lack of proper career guidance severely impacts mental health of early career researchers.

NWO, together with UNL and NFU is working on a working group to monitor and address the mental health of young researchers. The first meeting is planned September 22<sup>nd</sup>.
