Synovial tissue macrophages heterogeneity across disease phases of Rheumatoid Arthritis

Stefano Alivernini, MD, PhD, is Consultant Rheumatologist and Academic Researcher at the Fondazione Policlinico Universitario A. Gemelli IRCCS in Rome, Italy, where he is in charge of the Synovial Tissue Biopsy Unit (SYNGem) at the Division of Rheumatology, which is actively involved in translational studies and tissue-driven clinical trials.

His research activity is focused on rheumatoid arthritis and psoriatic rthritis with specific interest in synovitis, mechanisms leading to tissue inflammation and its resolution, and on biomarker discovery for personalized treatment of inflammatory arthritis. He has published several seminal papers on this topic in high-ranking journals including Nature Medicine, Science Advances and the Annals of the Rheumatic Diseases.
