Trained immunity: from mechanisms to disease

Prof. Mihai Netea is Head of the Division of Experimental Medicine, Department of Internal Medicine, Nijmegen University Nijmegen Medical Center.

He is mainly interested in understanding the factors influencing variability of human immune responses, the biology of sepsis and immunoparalysis in bacterial and fungal infections. He proposed the concept of "trained immunity", which is now widely adopted and studied in multiple research areas.

For his work he received many prestigious prizes and awards, including the Spinoza Prize 2016. He is a member of the Netherlands Royal Academy of Science (KNAW).
