Adapting radiotherapy prescription to immune checkpoint blockade

Dr. Silvia Formenti is Chair of the Department of Radiation Oncology, Professor of Radiation Oncology and Medicine, Associate Director of Translational Research at the Sandra and Edward Meyer Cancer Center at Weill Cornell Medicine, and Radiation Oncologist-in-Chief at NewYork-Presbyterian/Weill Cornell Medical Center. She is also the Sandra and Edward Meyer Professor of Cancer Research at Weill Cornell Medicine and leading eighteen investigator-initiated clinical trials of immunotherapy and radiotherapy. As a prolific researcher, Dr. Formenti has published nearly 300 papers recognized by high-impact journals including Nature Medicine, JAMA, Lancet Oncology and the Journal of Clinical Oncology. In 2019. She was honored to receive the ASTRO Gold Medal in 2019 and SITC Team Science Award in 2021.
