Clinical Impact Award 2020

Objective:

Each year, the Cancer Center Amsterdam grants a clinical impact award. This award is for (research) projects/products which resulted in a clear clinical and/or societal impact on practice in the field of oncology.

Due to the COVID-19 situation, it is likely that the award ceremony will be an online event.

Terms/conditions:

- The award is given to an individual or a team whose 'product' resulted in a clinical or societal impact on practice in the field of oncology.
- The product can have many forms, such as a course, an organization, a platform, a guideline, a public campaign, an instrument or even a publication ,etc.
- The product must be of high quality, be innovative, and must have societal or clinical impact on treatment or quality of life of patients.
- The clinical impact of the project was most pronounced between 1 December 2019 and 1 December 2020.
- The applicant must be an employee of the Cancer Center Amsterdam and should have played a significant part in the development of the product.
- The applications for this award will be evaluated on quality, novelty, relevance and clinical impact.

Call:

- Applicants must submit the application form for the clinical impact award.
- The deadline for applications is March 11th 2021 (cca@amsterdamumc.nl).
- Applications will be evaluated by the CCA research board. After selection of the highest ranked applications, people can vote on the nominees.
